

# recipe card instructions

## materials needed:

- :: this pdf
- :: a printer
- :: cardstock to print on (8.5" by 11")
- :: a paper cutter OR a craft knife and straight edge

## step one: print.

I recommend using cardstock and your printer's highest quality setting for the sharpest printout. I designed this printable set to be printed on standard letter-sized paper (8.5" by 11"). It looks great on plain white but you might also experiment with different colored cardstock. I especially like the look of brown kraft paper for a natural, earthy sort of look.

## step two: cut.

Cut using the crop marks as your guides. I recommend you use a paper cutter to keep nice straight lines and right angles, but a craft knife with a ruler is fine, too.

## step three: enjoy!
